

### Application of GILUMASC®:

The client should lie still for the application of GILUMASC®, so that the material does not crack during setting. The treatment lasts approximately 20 minutes. Direct contact with eyes, ears, nose and mouth must be avoided to prevent injury.

The temperature rises to a maximum of 45°C during the first few minutes and then falls slowly to room temperature.

1. When applying to the face the customer's hair must be bound back with a headband and the eyes protected by pads of cotton wool.
2. Apply a fatty cream or lotion containing active ingredients to the face.
3. Mix 430 g GILUMASC® with 215 ml water at about 20°C in a plastic bowl.
4. Apply an approx. 1 cm thick layer of the mixture to the face; leave the nostrils free.
5. The mask becomes warm, the pores open and the active ingredients can penetrate the skin.

The mask sets and then begins to cool. The solid mask can be removed after approx. 20 minutes.
